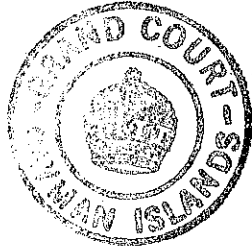

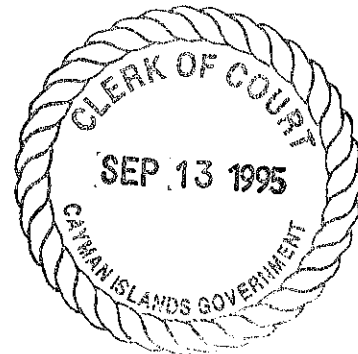

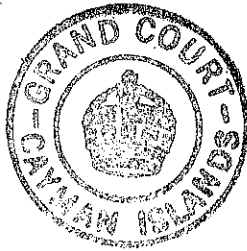

By this Originating Summons, which is issued on the application of Eden Kensington Cook-Bodden as the Administrator of the Estate of William Eden Snr. the plaintiff seeks the determination of this honourable court on the following questions, namely:-

1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to retain and be paid out of the trust estate the costs of and relating to an action brought by Moses I. Kirkconnell and Dorothy A. Boggs in the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands known as Grand Court Cause No. 236 of 1991, including in such costs all charges and expenses properly incurred by him as trustee of the estate of William Eden Snr. in relation to such action.
2. That the costs of and incidental to this application be paid out of the estate of William Eden Snr.

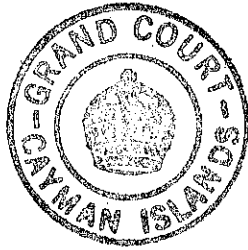

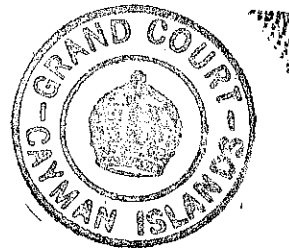
**Notes on address for Service**

*Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.*
