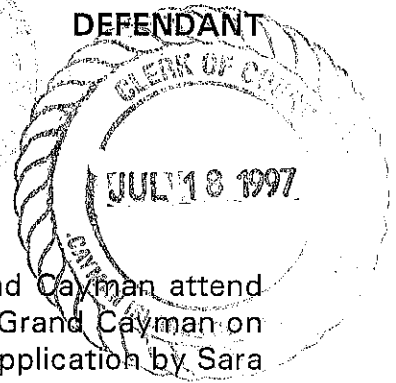
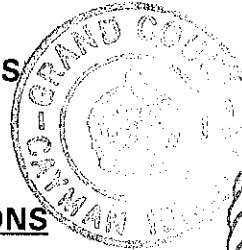

1. The Defendant restore Sara Maria to the Register of Companies on payment of reinstatement and any other fees due and thereupon Sara Maria shall be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off the Register of Companies.
2. Such further or other relief as the Court may think just.
3. The Defendant advertise the restoration in the Cayman Islands Gazette upon service on him of a duly sealed copy of the Order granted.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this Summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts office.
