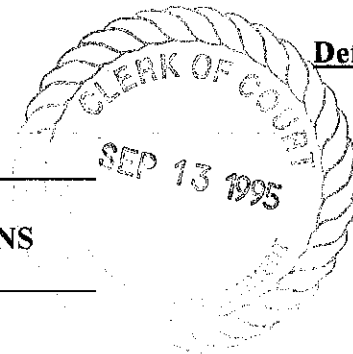
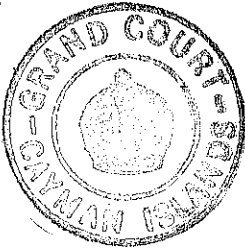

3. That such other order may be made in the premises as the Court shall deem fit.

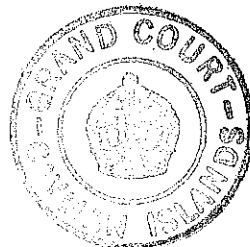
