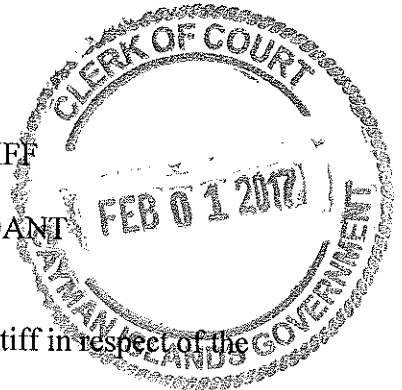
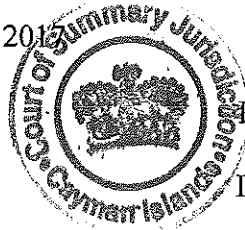


PLAINT

IN THE SUMMARY COURT OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

WITHIN 14 DAYS AFTER SERVICE OF THIS Plaintiff on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court's Office, P.O.Box 495,GT,Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service form stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action in whole or in part, you must set out full particulars of your defence in the space provided in the Acknowledgment of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or fail to return the Acknowledgment of Service form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for a default judgment without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is an Attorney-at-law licensed to practice in the Caayman Islands
2. The Defendant resides in Grand Cayman and was at all material times a client of the Plaintiff.
3. Between 2013 and 2015 the Plaintiff provided contractual legal services by way of representing her in divorce proceeding in the Grand Court resulting in a balance owing to the plaintiff of CI\$1,000.00
4. That despite demands for payment, the defendant has failed/refused to pay the said balance.
5. In the premises, the said sum remains due and owing to the plaintiff.

WHEREFORE THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS FROM THE DEFENDANT:

1. The said sum of CI\$1,000.00.
2. Costs
3. Such further and/or other relief as the Honourable Court deems appropriate.
