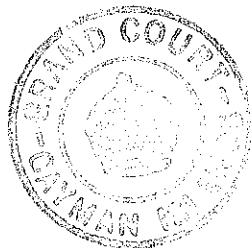


EX PARTE ORIGINATING APPLICATION
