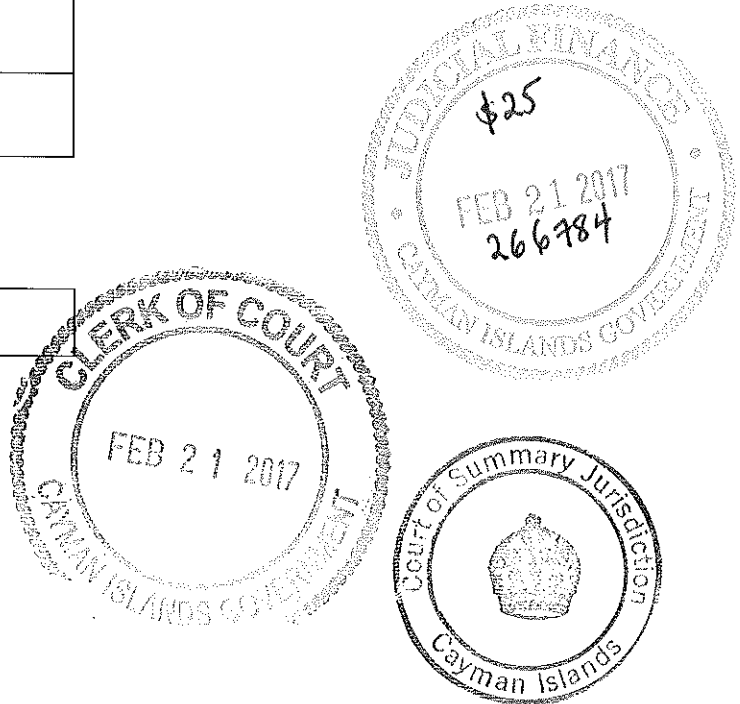

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM


(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendants is indebted to the Plaintiff or is liable to pay damages to the Plaintiff)

1. That the Defendant charged the cost of airline tickets to an unauthorized account by an employee of the Plaintiff that did not have the permission of the Plaintiff to extend this charge to the Defendant.
2. The Defendant has been contacted numerous times after it was realized that the charge had not been settled when the Plaintiff began an audit of the company ticket sales.
3. The Defendant was sent a Letter of Demand on May 12th, 2015 by registered post RD 01122257 8 KY.
4. A subsequent letter was sent again to the Defendant by post on September 30th, 2015.
5. The Defendant was given 14 days to settle the outstanding debt, or produce receipts that the debt had been settled.
6. To date the Defendant has not responded to the Letter of Demand, or made any efforts to communicate with the Plaintiff to settle said outstanding sums.
7. The Plaintiff now seeks the assistance of the Courts to remedy this outstanding unpaid debt.

The Plaintiff is owed **US\$1649.90** plus cost, interest and fixed cost.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

1. The Plaintiff is claiming the sum of **US1649.90** being the outstanding amount free of interest.
3. Interest on the sum at the rate of to be **prescribed by the Court** per annum.
4. Interest to continue until the matter is settled and together with other cost the Courts assessed for this action.
5. Fixed cost of **US\$500.00**, alternatively cost to be assessed by this Court.

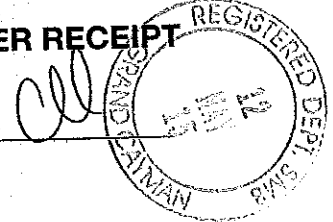
