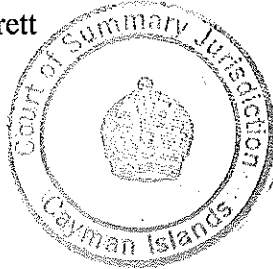

**PARTICULARS OF CLAIM**



1. The Plaintiff is an Attorney-at-law licensed to practice in the Cayman Islands with offices located at 67 Artemis House, George Town, Grand Cayman.
2. The 1<sup>st</sup> defendant is a company/business entity of the 2<sup>nd</sup> defendant and is and was at all material times a customer of the plaintiff.
3. The 2<sup>nd</sup> defendant resides in Grand Cayman and is and was at all material times a customer of the plaintiff.
4. The plaintiff rendered contractual legal services to the defendants between Sept-October 2016 resulting in fees amounting to CI\$1,516.00 which despite several demands the defendants have failed/refused to pay.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS FROM THE DEFENDANTS:-

1. The said sum of CI\$1,516.00
1. Interest on the said sum pursuant to the Judicature Law(2007 Revision) and the Judgment Debt Rates as amended from time to time.
