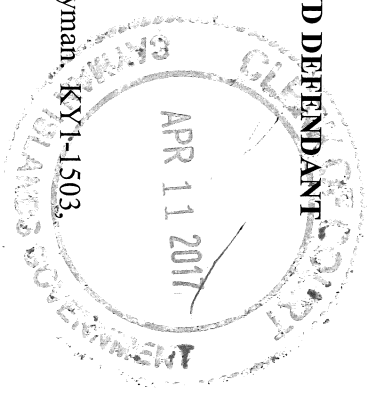

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a Bank carrying on business at its branch at PO Box 68, 25 Main Street, George Town, Grand Cayman and elsewhere, and the Defendants are an at all material times, have been customers of the Plaintiff.
2. The Defendants are currently indebted to the Plaintiff in respect of a Current Loan Account #10459760 in the principal sum of \$28,108.52, together with interest of \$115.92.
3. The Plaintiff has made a written demand for repayment by letter from its attorneys dated 23 November 2016 served on the Defendants on 24 November 2016 but the Defendants have failed to repay the said sum.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS AGAINST THE DEFENDANTS:

1. Payment of the principal sum of CI\$28,108.52;
2. Interest of CI\$115.92 on the above principal sum at the rate of 10.75% per annum, a daily rate of CI\$8.28, from the date of issue of these proceedings and continuing thereafter until payment.
