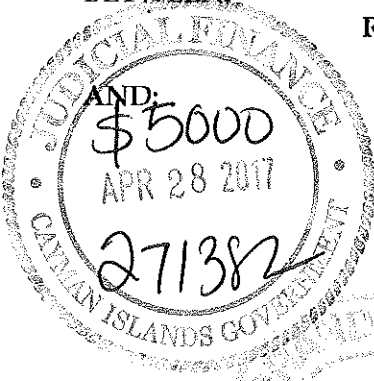

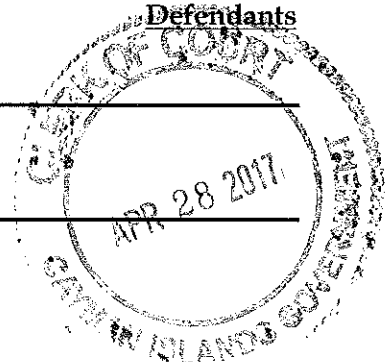

ORIGINATING SUMMONS




TO: The Defendants, IDF and MF

LET THE DEFENDANTS, within 14 days after service of this Originating Summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts the Registrar, Financial Services Division, Court Office, PO Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1106, Cayman Islands.

BY THIS ORIGINATING SUMMONS, which is issued on the application of Rawlinson & Hunter Trustees SA (the Plaintiff) as the Trustee of the trusts of the settlement dated 5 July 2005 made by MBT Trustees Ltd known as the Stingray Trust, the Plaintiff seeks the following relief pursuant to GCR O.85 r.2(2)(a):

1. An order that, having been made a defendant to an action in the Lugano District Court, Lugano, Switzerland, bearing File No CA.2015.578/579 brought by IDF (the **Swiss Proceedings**), the Plaintiff be at liberty to defend the Swiss Proceedings through to trial, including any interlocutory applications and any appeals therefrom, and to take all necessary steps as advised by Swiss counsel;
2. That the Plaintiff be indemnified against all and any costs and expenses arising out of, and incidental to, the said action (including such costs and expenses incurred prior to the making of the order in paragraph 1) out of the trust assets/out of the estate of the said deceased, including for the avoidance of doubt, its own professional charges at their current published rate for the time of its own employees spent in dealing with the conduct of the litigation;
3. That provision be made for the costs of this application.
