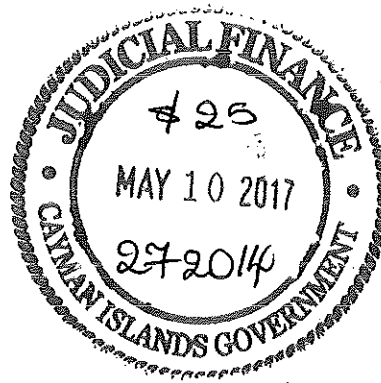

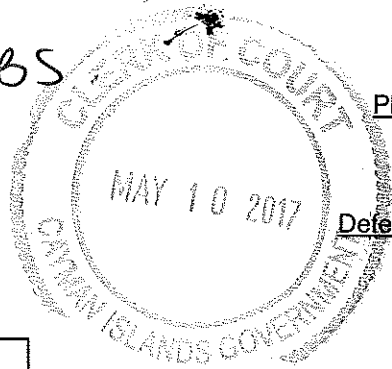

1. February/March 2017. Defendant agreed with Plaintiff to produce large high quality costumes for Batabano 2017 (May 6th 2017). Both parties agreed on a sum of USD\$450 per costume (including the body suits) for 9 costumes, an additional costume at US\$350 and another (including body suit) at USD\$600. It was further agreed that a total of 11 costumes were to be made. Defendant sent sketches of the costumes and these were agreed on between both parties. Defendant confirmed that he would construct the bases of the costumes in Trinidad and ship to Cayman. Defendant intended to arrive in Cayman 3 weeks before Batabano, where he would complete and put the costumes together (including body suits), as if this was done before shipping the costumes would be damaged. Defendant was to bring all required materials with him to Cayman. At no time did he ask the Plaintiff's to produce any material. The Plaintiff's provided a location where he would be able to complete the costumes
2. Defendant was paid in full by April 2nd 2017, with a balance of US\$67, due to be paid upon his arrival in Cayman, which was intended to be April 21st, but he arrived on April 28th. Once he arrived in Cayman, he continued to promise that the costumes would be finished and completed by Saturday May 6th.
3. The week coming up to Batabano, the Defendant continued to promise the costumes would be completed. There was little to no work done
4. May 6th 2017. Costumes were not completed.
5. We are seeking compensation of US\$5,000.
