

The Relief Sought

1. An Order of Certiorari to remove into this Honourable Court and to quash the decision of the Chief Immigration Officer and/or the Deputy Chief Immigration Officer and or the Immigration Department to revoke the Plaintiff Grant of Caymanian Status conferred on him on 11 September 1991.
2. An Order of Mandamus directed to the Respondent's requiring them to acknowledge the Applicant's Cayman Status.
3. Interim relief in the form of an injunction pending the determination of this application and any further formal application restraining the Chief Immigration Officer and/or the Deputy Chief Immigration Officer and/or any servant or agent of the Immigration Department or the Respondent or any of them from sending the Plaintiff Rowan Anthony Mullings out of the Cayman Islands and an Order permitting him to work in the Cayman Islands, until these proceedings for Judicial Review and any further formal application to remain in the Cayman Islands are heard and determined.
4. Such further on other Relief as the Court may determine is Just.

## GROUNDNS ON WHICH RELIEF IS SOUGHT

### 1. The Facts.

The factual background to this application for leave for Judicial Review is contained in the Affidavit of Rowan Anthony Mullings that has been filed with this application and this Affidavit will be relied on in support of the application on the following grounds.

2. The Applicant was granted Caymanian Status in September 1991. The Applicant remained in the Cayman Islands and travelled on his Cayman Status Letter. His Status was not indorsed on his passport.
3. After his passport expired, the Applicant applied to renew it. He was told that he had no Caymanian Status. He was forced by the Immigration Department to apply for Permanent Residence with a Right to work. The Applicant could not find his Caymanian Status Letter.
4. Sometime later the Applicant's mother discovered a copy of the Applicant's Caymanian Status Letter among her papers. The Applicant presented this Copy of his Status Letter to the Chief Immigration Officer. The Chief Immigration Officer, refuted the legality of the Applicant's Status Letter, accusing the Applicant of uttering a forged document, the Chief immigration Officer contended that where no copy of the Applicant's Status letter on the Immigration was files.
5. The Applicant is now relegated by the Immigration to the Status of that of a Visitor with a Visitors Stamp in his current passport. The Applicant has lived, worked, and resided in the Cayman Islands for many years. The Applicant came to the Cayman Islands from Jamaica at the age of 3 months old. The Applicant is now 45 years of age.
