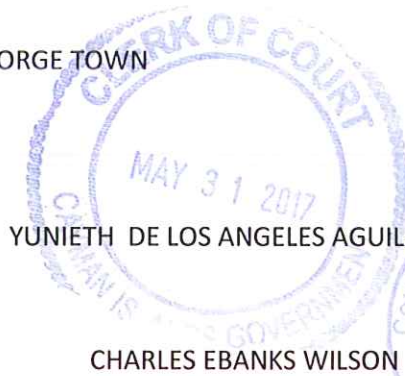

If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out full particulars of your defense in the space provided in the Acknowledgement of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or fail to return the Acknowledgement of Service form containing full particulars of your defense, the Plaintiff may apply for a default Judgment without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM


(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to her or is liable to pay damages to her)

- 1 On Monday 17th April 2017 the Plaintiff who works with the Defendant loan him the sum of \$400:00 CI with the intention that he was going to repay her by the end of the month.
- 2 On Friday 12th May 2017 the Plaintiff loaned an additional the sum of \$600:00 CI which is a total of \$1000:00 CI to the Defendant.
- 3 The Plaintiff contacted the Defendant in relation to the repayment of the money and he refuse to pay her or make any arrangements for payments.
4. On Sunday 21st May 2017 the Plaintiff went to George Town Police Station for assistance in getting her money from the Defendant who is refusing to pay her.
5. The Defendant informed the Police that he would repay the Plaintiff the sum of \$1000:00 on Thursday 25th May 2017 which was the day he would receive his salary.
6. On Thursday 25th May 2017 the Plaintiff contacted the Defendant in order to get her money from him since he received his salary. The Defendant refused to repay her the money he owes.
7. The Plaintiff continued to try and contact the Defendant but he refuses to answer his phone, she discovered that he will be leaving the island at the end of June 2017 and desires to have him pay her the sum owed.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

- (1) The sum of \$1000.00
- (2) Fixed costs of \$250.00, alternatively costs to be assessed.
