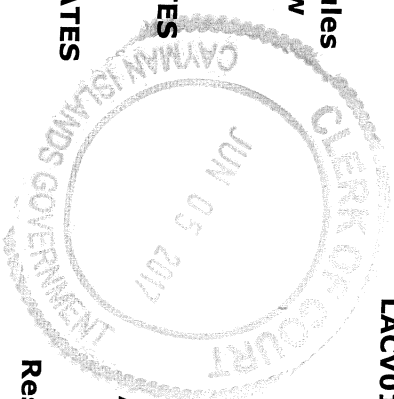

**ORIGINATING SUMMONS**



**LET THE DEFENDANT** of Apt #13, 51c Nightgale Manor, Spotts, Newlands attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2017, at o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff, Antoinette Yates of Apt #13, 51c Nightgale Manor, Spotts, Newlands that;

1. The Applicant be appointed guardian of Antoinette Yates ("the Patient") and over her estate and effects until such time as the Patient becomes of sound mind with the following powers conferred upon her:-
  - (a) To make decisions about the Patient's care, treatment and personal welfare;
  - (b) To control and manage the Patients property and affairs assets of the Patient;
2. The Applicant be appointed Receiver in relation to the administration of the estate of the Patient.
3. That the Applicant shall keep proper records, books and accounts of the administration and management of the property of the Patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in Court copies of such records, books and accounts.

**AND LET THE DEFENDANT** within 14 days after service of this summons on her counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.

NOTES:-

- (1) This Summons may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect
- (2) service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the above date unless renewed by order of the Court.
- (2) If a defendant does not attend personally or by his attorney at the time and place above-mentioned such order will be made as the Court may think just and expedient.

**IMPORTANT**

Directions for Acknowledgment of Service are given with the accompanying form.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE  
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion, it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

**Notes for Guidance**

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

**Attorney:** where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.


