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**LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED** attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July 2017 at            o'clock on the hearing of an application on the part of Deborah Musson of 56 Coral Ridge Drive, Savannah, Grand Cayman and/or Diane Eleanor Musson McDonald of 36 Sandalwood Crescent, South Sound, Grand Cayman and/or Barbara Eleanor Musson of 36 Sandalwood Crescent, South Sound, Grand Cayman ("**the Applicants**") who are, respectively, the two daughters and wife of Clive Waldorf Musson for the following orders and directions:-


1. That the Applicants be appointed guardians and/or receivers for the said **Clive Waldorf Musson** ("**the patient**") and over his estate and effects with the following powers

conferred upon them pursuant to sections 18 and 19 of The Mental Health Law (2013 Revision) and section 14 of the Grand Court Law (2015 Revision):

- 1.1 To manage, sell, acquire, charge or deal with any property of the patient;
- 1.2 To enter into any settlement on behalf of the patient;
- 1.3 To provide for the management of any business of the patient;
- 1.4 To dissolve any partnership of the patient;
- 1.5 To complete any contracts on behalf of the patient; in particular to sign all documents necessary to complete the pending sale of the property known as apartment 21 Fountain Court, Grand Cayman (Registration section South Sound Block and Parcel No. 15B 331H19), which property is owned by Clive Waldorf Musson, Barbara Eleanor Musson and Deborah Musson as joint proprietors.
- 1.6 To conduct legal proceedings on behalf of the patient;
- 1.7 To act as trustee on behalf of the patient
- 1.8 To invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to the patient in such securities as the Applicants for the time being are authorised by law to invest trust funds;
- 1.9 Open and maintain a current account in any bank in the Cayman Islands and to deposit therein and/or withdraw therefrom such monies as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the patient.

2. The Applicants shall keep proper accounts of their administration and management of the property of the patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in Court copies of such accounts; the first such account covering the period of one year from the date of this Order is to be submitted within 1 month from the end of such period.
3. The costs of this application and the costs of the guardians and/or receivers incident and consequent upon the Order herein shall be paid from the estate and property of the patient.
4. Such consequential or other directions as may be necessary.
