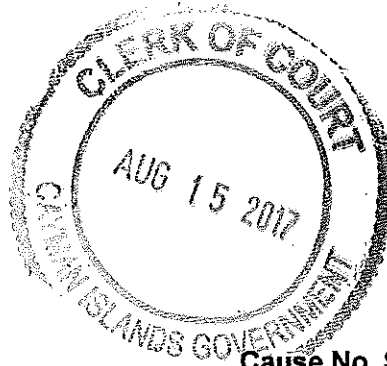

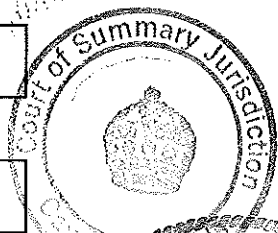

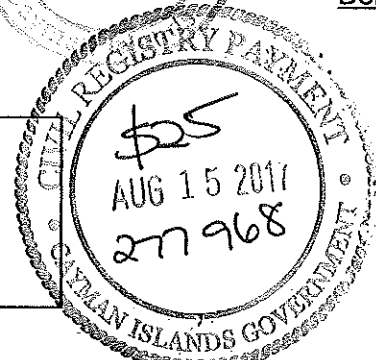

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The plaintiff is a Cayman Islands registered company with its registered office at P.O. Box 10724, Grand Cayman and in the business of service and sales of swimming pools and their related equipment.
2. The defendant entered into a contract with the plaintiff in July of 2006, for the servicing of the defendant's swimming pool including the supply of chemicals required to maintain the pool water.
3. The plaintiff provided this service until July of 2009 however the last service that the defendant paid for was in April of 2008.
4. Service to the swimming pool was suspended however, the defendant continued to obtain chemical from the plaintiff until October 2009.
5. Although the defendant admitted to owing the plaintiff money the defendant has refused to pay any of the outstand sum as stated below.
