


PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is an individual who is an Attorney-at-law licensed to practice in the Cayman Islands with offices located at suite 10, 2nd Floor, Jack & Jill Building, 19 Fort Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands
2. The Defendant is an individual and his mailing address is PO Box 125, Grand Cayman KY1-1501, Cayman Islands.
3. On October 25, 2011, at the request of the Defendant, the Plaintiff made a loan to the Defendant in the amount of CI\$10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Cayman Islands Dollars), to be repaid by the Defendant in full with no interest thereon on, by April 30, 2012.
4. The Defendant defaulted on the terms of repayment and despite various requests for payment the Defendant has refused or neglected to repay the loan amount.
5. On June 1, 2017, a formal demand for the outstanding loan amount of CI\$10,000.00 was sent to the Defendant by registered and regular mail.
6. Notwithstanding the formal demand for payment, the Defendant has failed or neglected to make payment.
7. As a result of the above, the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief claimed in this proceeding.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

- a) The sum of CI\$10,000.00;
- b) Such further and other relief as this Court may deem just; and
