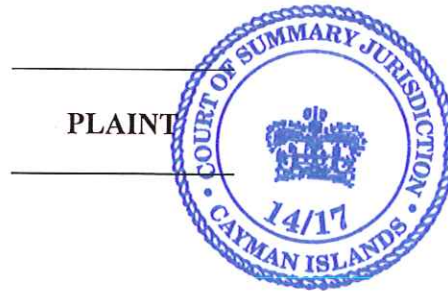

1. The Plaintiff is a Bank carrying on business at its branch at Elgin Avenue, PO Box 1097, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1102 and elsewhere, and the Defendant is and at all material times, has been a customer of the Plaintiff at the said branch.
2. The Defendant is currently indebted to the Plaintiff in respect of a Credit Card Account ending #0009 in the principal sum of US\$1,830.67, plus interest which will continue to accrue at the rate of 18%.
2. The Plaintiff demanded payment of the debt due by a letter from its attorneys dated 18 July 2017. The Defendant has failed to pay the debt due to the Plaintiff.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS AGAINST THE DEFENDANT:

1. Payment of the said sum of US\$1,830.67;
2. Interest on the above principal sum at the rate of 18%, and continuing until payment at the same rate pursuant to the Plaintiff's standard banking terms and conditions.
3. Costs.
