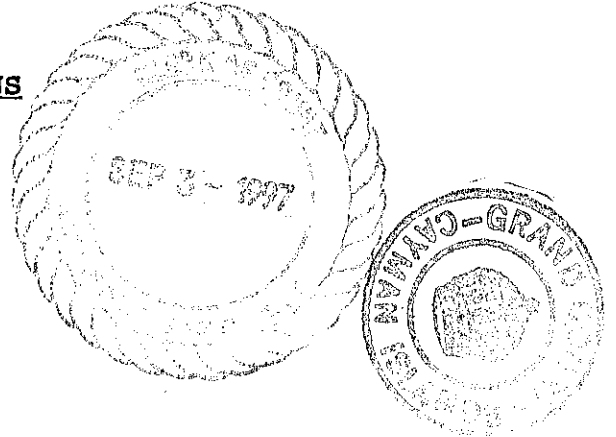

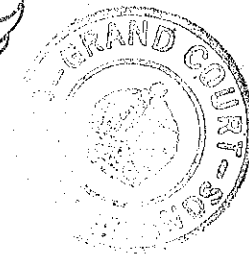

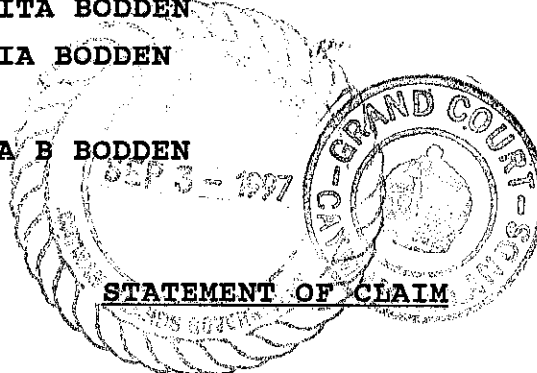

3. The Second Plaintiff is the legitimate child of the said Yolanda Bodden nee Martinez Ingram and the said Bethel Ewen Bodden, being born on the 3rd August 1973.
4. The said Bethel Ewen Bodden deserted the said Yolanda Bodden nee Martinez Ingram in 1976.
5. The said Bethel Ewen Bodden died intestate on or about the 2nd March 1997. On the 6th day of June 1997 Letters of Administration were granted to the Defendant who purports to be the widow of the deceased.

AND THE PLAINTIFFS CLAIM:

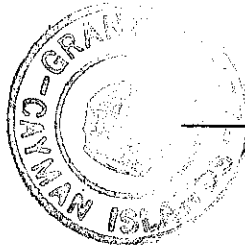
- (1) A declaration that each of them are the lawful legitimate children of Bethel Ewen Bodden.

**AND THE PLAINTIFFS AND EACH OF THEM CLAIM:**

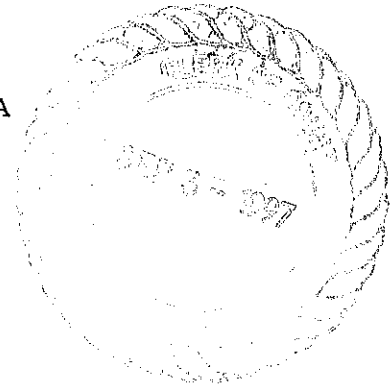
An Injunction to restrain the Defendant by herself her servants or agents or howsoever otherwise from distributing the estate as Bethel Ewen Bodden.
