1. The Plaintiff is a Bank carrying on business at its branch at Elgin Avenue, PO Box 1097, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1102 and elsewhere, and the Defendant is and at all material times, has been a customer of the Plaintiff at the said branch.
2. The Defendant is currently indebted to the Plaintiff in respect of a Current Overdrawn Account #022-18945 in the principal sum of US\$2,280.66 as at 22 September 2017, plus interest which will continue to accrue at the rate of US\$0.83 per diem until payment.
3. The Plaintiff has made written demand for payment of the arrears on the Current Overdrawn Account by letter dated 29 November 2017 and served on the Defendant on the 01 December 2017 from its attorneys but the Defendant has failed to repay the said sum. The Plaintiff now seeks repayment of the full amount now due under the Loan Account.

### **AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS AGAINST THE DEFENDANT:**

1. Payment of the said sum of US\$2,280.66;
2. Interest on the above principal sum at the rate of US\$.83 per diem, and continuing until payment at the same rate pursuant to the Plaintiff's standard banking terms and conditions.
