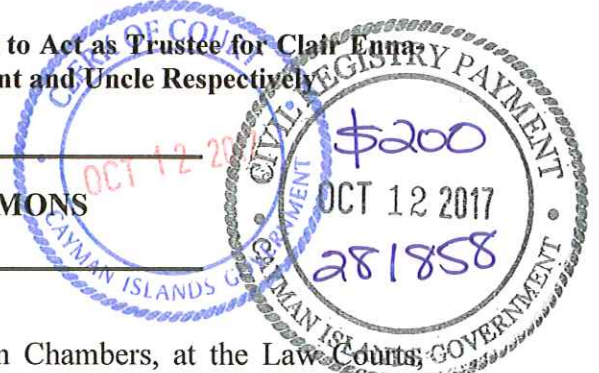

DRAFT EX PARTE ORDER APPOINTING TRUSTEE

BEFORE Mr. Justice _____ in Chambers;

UPON hearing counsel for the Applicant and reading the documents in the court file;

AND UPON being satisfied concerning all necessary aspects of this Application;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Pursuant to sections 18(a) and 19(a) of the Law, Ellen Ann Kelly Vernon (“**Ellen** “), being a suitable “nearest relative” as defined in section 2 of the Law, be appointed with immediate effect to act as trustee for her aunt and uncle, Enna-Lee Ebanks (“**Enna-Lee** “) and Roy Ebanks (“**Roy**”) respectively, they both being patients as defined in section 2 of the Law who are (by reason of their mental impairment) incapable of managing and administering their own property and affairs.
2. As trustee, Ellen shall have the following duties and/or powers in relation to Enna-Lee and Roy:
 - a. To do (and secure the doing of) all such things as appear to Ellen to be desirable for their maintenance and/or benefit and/or otherwise for administering their affairs and/or making provision for them, including managing and/or dealing with their property (such as cheques issued in their name or for their benefit);
 - b. To ensure that they both continue to receive the best personal care and supervision that is reasonably feasible;
 - c. To make such medical and/or other decisions for them as may be required from time to time concerning their mental impairment and/or physical condition and/or overall well-being; and
 - d. To consult with such medical doctors and/or other relevant professionals as may be necessary respecting their mental impairment and/or physical condition and/or overall well-being.
