CONCISE STATEMENT OF THE RELIEF SOUGHT

THE PLAINTIFF SEEKS A DECLARATION THAT

The rights of the Plaintiff under the Bill of Rights, Freedoms and Responsibilities have been breached and denied by the actions or omissions of the Royal Cayman Islands Police Service and its officers that is the right to, at any stage and at his own expense, retain and instruct without delay a legal practitioner of his or her own choice, and to hold private communication with him or her, while being detained or arrested.

THE PLAINTIFF ALSO SEEKS A DECLARATION THAT

On the 18th of June 2016, the rights of the Plaintiff under the Police Law to retain and communicate with an Attorney-at-law ~~without delay, once he so requested~~, while being ~~detained or arrested~~ ~~arrested and held in custody~~, have been breached and denied, and this in a manner and for reasons not in conformity with the said Law, by the actions and omissions of the Royal Cayman Islands Police Service and its officers.
