

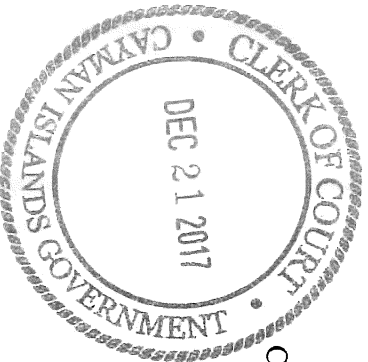

Judgment, order, decision or other proceeding in respect of which relief is sought	DECISION BY CHIEF IMMIGRATION OFFICER DEMANDING THAT THE APPLICANT DEPART FROM THE CAYMAN ISLANDS HAVING REFUSED THE GRANT OF FURTHER EXTENSION OF HIS AUTHORITY TO REMAIN IN BREACH OF HIS LEGAL RIGHTS UNDER SECTION 15,31 OF Immigration law. Articles 9,13, 14, 17, 24 of C.I. Constitution

Relief Sought -

1. An order of Mandamus directing the Respondents whether by himself his agents or otherwise to refrain from any and all actions in relation to the Applicants status on the island or liberty pursuant to the Applicant availing herself of the provisions contained in Article 13(2) and 13(2)(a-c) of the Cayman Islands Constitution Order 2009
2. An order that the respondents whether by himself his servants, agents or otherwise be restrained and prohibited from any and all actions, the objective of which is the detention and expulsion of the Applicant from the Cayman Islands, under any provision of the Immigration Law until he has been afforded the legal right of appeal as provided for under Section 15 of the Immigration Law 2015 and a determination made by the Immigration Appeal Tribunal.
3. Applicant poses not threat to the interests of the states defences.
4. Such further consequential or other relief as this Honourable Court sees fit
