## STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is and was at all material times a Company duly incorporated in the Cayman Islands and carrying on the business of providing domestic services.
2. On or about the 6<sup>th</sup> October the Defendant entered into a Contract with the Plaintiff to provide domestic services for and to the Defendant.
3. Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the said contract the Plaintiff provided domestic services for and to the Defendant of which she would pay the Plaintiff's invoices sent to her from time to time.
4. The Plaintiff sent the following invoices to the Defendant but received no payments from the Defendant on them:
  - (1) Invoice No. 4582 dated 28/5/17 for CI\$ 1080:00
  - (2) Invoice No. 4659 dated 30/6/17 for CI\$ 1206:00
  - (3) Invoice No. 4692 dated 7/7/17 for CI\$ 132:00
5. The Plaintiff sent numerous correspondence to the Defendant to remind her to make payments on the said invoices. The Defendant's correspondence went unanswered. However, on or above 29 July 2017 the Defendant agreed with the Plaintiff to pay the invoiced amounts outstanding. But the Defendant failed to pay as promised.
6. Subsequently, the Defendant blocked the Plaintiff's telephone calls to her telephone. She did no reply to the Plaintiff's email messages demanding payment.
7. Notwithstanding all the Plaintiff's demands to the Defendant for payment of the Plaintiff's said invoices she has refused to pay.

And The Plaintiff Claims:-

1. The Sum of CI\$ 2,418:00;
2. Interest at the said amount as per statute;
3. Cost of CI\$ 350:00;
4. Court Cost CI\$ 25:00;
5. Service Cost CI\$ 60:00.

6. Such further or other relief as the Honourable deem fit.
