THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

**Within 14 days** after service of this Plaintiff on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service form stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out **full particulars of your defence** in the space provided in the Acknowledgement of Service form.

**If you fail** to satisfy the claim or fail to return the Acknowledgement of Service form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for a **default judgment** without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to him or is liable to pay damages to him)

The car was purchased from Ms Robinson for \$5,500 CI by way of installments. On November 2nd 2017, \$3,800 CI was paid with an agreement that a further \$500 CI would be paid on November 10th and the remaining \$1200 CI would be paid at a later unfixed date. Mr. Hunter subsequently took the vehicle to be inspected and determined that it had an oil leak. Ms Robinson stated that the car had been serviced by Arch Automotive however she would prefer the oil leak be dealt with by her personal mechanic a gentleman named Corey. Mr Hunter brought the vehicle to Corey however the mechanic refused to fix the vehicle as Ms Robinson had an outstanding bill from previous works performed on the vehicle. Mr Hunter contacted Ms Robinson and explained the situation enquiring when and how she would clear the outstanding bill with Corey and asked if he could take the vehicle to an alternative mechanic such as Arch Automotive to be fixed. However Ms Robinson stated the vehicle was only to be serviced by Corey and that the outstanding amount owed to him was not of Mr Hunters concern. Mr Hunter explained that Corey would not work on the vehicle until the outstanding bill had been paid. Mr Hunter, unable to have the vehicle fixed to good working order has informed Ms Robinson that he will not be making the final payment owed on the car and instead would ask that his monies paid be returned. Ms Robinson has informed Mr Hunter that she will not allow the car to be fixed elsewhere nor will she return his money.

1. The sum of \$4,300

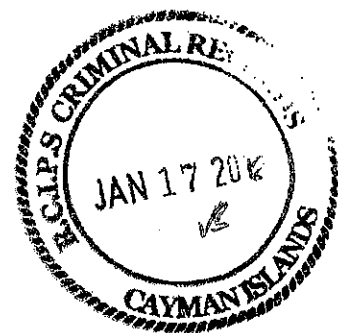

## DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE

1. The accompanying form of ***Acknowledgment of Service*** should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person

After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman

2. A Defendant who states in his Acknowledgment of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings ***must also serve a defence*** on the Attorney for the Plaintiff (or on the Plaintiff if acting in person).

If a Statement of Claim is indorsed on the Writ (i.e. the words "Statement of Claim" appear on the top of page 2), the Defence must be served within 14 days after the time for acknowledging service of the Writ, unless in the meantime a summons for judgment is served on the Defendant.

If the Statement of Claim is not indorsed on the Writ, the Defence need not be served until 14 days after a Statement of Claim has been served on the Defendant

If the Defendant fails to serve his defence within the appropriate time, the Plaintiff may enter judgment against him without further notice.

3. A ***Stay of Execution*** against the Defendant's goods may be applied for where the Defendant is unable to pay the money for which any judgment is entered. If a Defendant to an action for a debt or liquidated demand (i.e. a fixed sum) who does not intend to contest the proceedings states, in answer to Question 3 in the Acknowledgment of Service, that he intends to apply for a stay, execution will be stayed for 14 days after his Acknowledgment, but he must, within that time, ***issue a Summons*** for a stay of execution, supported by an affidavit of his means. The affidavit should state any offer which the Defendant desires to make for payment of the money by installments or otherwise.
