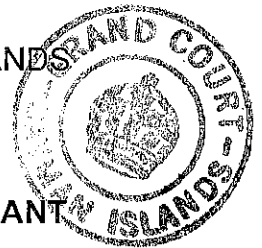

**ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

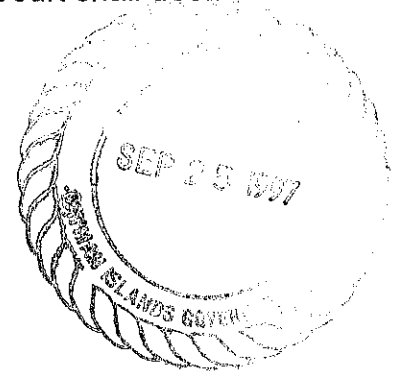

3. That such other Order may be made in the premises as the Court shall deem fit.

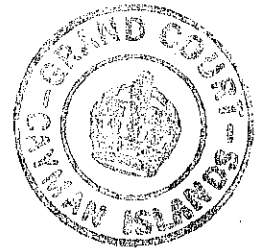
