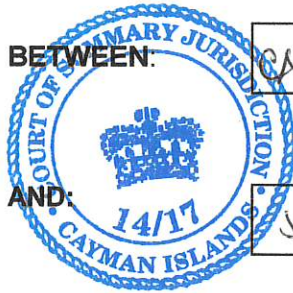

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

- 1.) 24 October 2017; 03 November 2018 and 23 December 2017 were done jobs for inspection and engine repair. Repair orders# 768; 769; 755; 810
- 2.) Jake Smith refuse to pay his invoices with argument that we didn't fix the problem with his engine. Problem with his engine was fixed, just his engine is not new and after repair when he used his engine again some other part was broken after short time of using and Jake Smith accusing our company all this time and refuse to pay his invoices.
- 3.) We tried to solve the problem without court and told him that if he is not happy with the service he can bring us his boat back and we will take out back the parts which was installed by us. Unfortunately, Jake Smith doesn't want to return the parts and doesn't want to pay for the service.

- (1) The sum of \$931.42
 - (2) Interest in the sum of 1.64\$ calculated at the prescribed rate from 10th November 2017; 20th November 2017; 20th January 2018 to date.
 - (3) Interest to continue at the per diem rate of \$0.01; 0.003 and 0.009 until this matter is settled.
 - (4) Fixed cost of \$175.00, alternatively cost to be assessed.
