

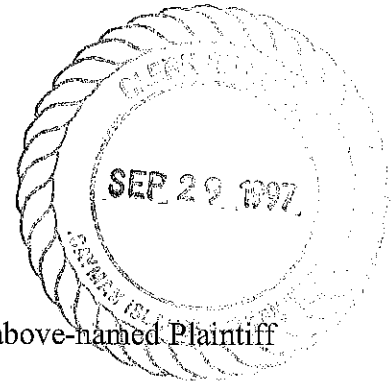

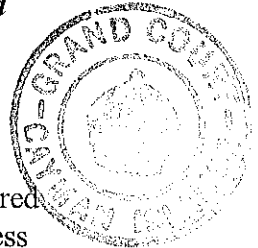
THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service, stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.



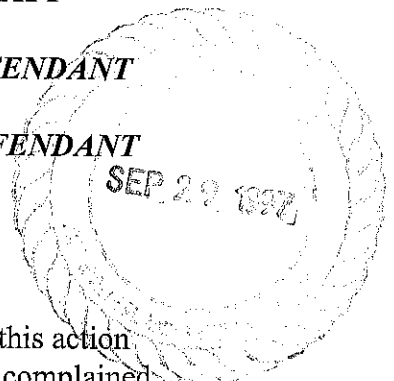

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is the Attorney-General of the Cayman Islands and brings this action under and by virtue of the Crown Proceedings Law for that the incident complained of involved a member of the Public Service, being a member of the Royal Cayman Islands Police Force, acting in the course of his duties as such.
2. The First Defendant was at all material times the driver of GMC Jimmy motor vehicle registered 35 456 and was at all material times the servant and/or agent of the Second Defendant.
3. The Second Defendant was at all material times the owner of GMC Jimmy motor vehicle registered 35 456.
4. On the 28th day of April 1995 at the junction of Airport Road and Owen Roberts Drive, Chevrolet Lumina motor vehicle registered 47 773 driven by PC Dave McLaughlin, a member of the Royal Cayman Islands Police Force, and owned by the Government of Vehicles Equipment and Services, was stationary on the said Owen Roberts Drive when the First Defendant, driving the aforesaid GMC Jimmy motor vehicle, in attempting to overtake the said stationary Chevrolet Lumina collided with the said motor vehicle.
5. That said collision was caused by the negligence of the said First Defendant.

Particulars of Negligence

- (a) Failing to keep any or any proper look out or to have any or any sufficient regard to other users of the said road and in particular to the Plaintiff's stationary vehicle;
- (b) Causing or permitting the said GMC Jimmy motor vehicle to collide with the Plaintiff's Chevrolet Lumina and/or failing to take any or any adequate measures to prevent the said collision;



- (c) Running into the Plaintiff's vehicle;
- (d) Failing to stop, swerve or in any other way so to manage or control the said GMC Jimmy so as to prevent the collision.

6. By reason of these matters the Plaintiff sustained damage and costs.

Particulars of Special Damages

Cost of repairs to Chevrolet Lumina 47 773 CI\$1,859.00

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

- 2. Interest at the Statutory rate from the date of accident to satisfaction of Judgement
- 3. Costs.
