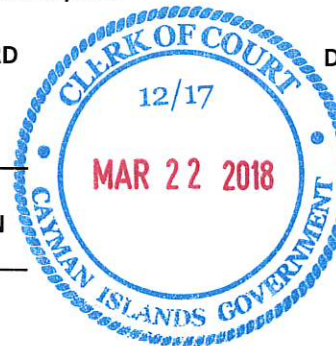

NOTICE OF MOTION



TAKE NOTICE that Justice _____ sitting at the Law Courts, George Town, on the _____ day of March 2018 at _____ am/pm, or as soon thereafter as Counsel can be heard on behalf of **SCOTIABANK & TRUST (CAYMAN) LTD** will be moved by Counsel for **SCOTIABANK & TRUST (CAYMAN) LTD** for an order pursuant to Part 1 of GCR Order 52, that the Court Bailiff, Richard Harford, be committed to prison on the grounds that he is in breach of the Order made by this Court on 21 February 2018 whereby the Court ordered the issuance of a Writ of Possession addressed to the Bailiff for execution and, contrary to the requirements of that Writ of Possession, he has failed to enforce it.

And for an order that the Defendant pay the costs of this application on an indemnity basis.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the grounds of this application are that on 21st February 2018, in Cause 22 of 2018, Ms Justice Mangatal gave the Plaintiff leave to issue a Writ of Possession to recover possession of the property known as Registration Section George Town East, Block 20D, Parcel 427H9 within seven days of the date of that Order. That Writ of Possession was duly issued on 5 March 2018 and delivered to the Defendant. Despite repeated requests the Defendant has refused to comply with the Writ of Possession and has failed to indicate when he will do so.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the Applicant intends to rely upon the affidavit of Laura Carter sworn on 8 March 2018 in support of this application, a copy of which is served herewith.
