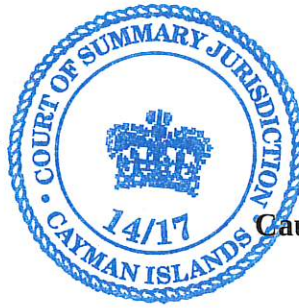

PLAINT

THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this **Plaint** on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service form stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out **full particulars of your defence** in the space provided in the acknowledgement of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or fail to return the acknowledgeable of Service form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for a **default judgment** without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is and was at all material times a company duly incorporated in the Cayman Islands in the business of providing short term unsecured loans.
2. The Defendant at the material times was a resident of the Cayman Islands.
3. By a written agreement dated 15 March 2013 and executed by the Defendant (hereinafter referred to as the "**Agreement**"), the Plaintiff agreed to advance the sum of CI\$ 300.00 to the Defendant.
4. The Defendant agreed to pay the Plaintiff the sum of CI\$ 345.00 (being repayment of the sum advanced together with interest) on or before 29 March 2013. The Defendant agreed to pay interest on the sum advanced of 7.5% per week.
5. At the time of entering into Agreement the Defendant was employed by Natiuonal Building Society and had a salary of CI \$30,000 per annum. Prior to entering into the Agreement, the Defendant provided to the Plaintiff evidence of employment in the Cayman Islands and proof of residential address.
6. The Defendant failed to pay the sum outstanding under the Agreement on 29 March 2013 or at all, despite demands for payment by the Plaintiff.
7. The Defendant agreed to interest pursuant to the Agreement at the rate of 7.5% per week. The contractual interest for the period 15 March 2013 to 30 October 2018 is CI\$ 6,576.43 continuing at a per diem rate of CI\$ 3.21.
8. A letter before action dated 22 August 2017 has been served on the Defendant. The Defendant was given 21 days of service of the letter before action to pay the amount due under the Agreement. The amount owed under the Agreement remains outstanding and there has been no response as of the date of this claim.
9. The Plaintiff is entitled to payment to the amount agreed upon between the parties under the Agreement including the principal sum advanced and interest.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

1. The sum of CI\$ 300.00.
2. Contractual interest at a total of CI\$ 6,576.43, as at 30 October 2018, and continuing at a per diem rate of CI\$ 3.21.
