PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a Bank carrying on business at its branch at PO Box 68, 25 Main Street, George Town, Grand Cayman and elsewhere, and the Defendant is and was at all material times, a customer of the Plaintiff.
2. The Defendant is currently indebted to the Plaintiff in respect of a Personal Loan Account in the principal sum of CI\$1,052.64, plus interest which will continue to accrue at the rate of 7% per annum until payment. The current arrears amount to CI\$1,014.52. The Personal Loan Account is repayable on demand.
3. The Plaintiff has made written demand for payment of the arrears on the Personal Loan Account by letter dated 06 March 2018 and served on the Defendant on the 07 March 2018 from its attorneys but the Defendant has failed to repay the said sum. The Plaintiff now seeks repayment of the full amount now due under the Personal Loan Account.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS AGAINST THE DEFENDANT:

1. Payment of the said sum of CI\$1,052.64;
2. Interest on the above principal sum at the rate of 7% per annum, and continuing until payment at the same rate pursuant to the Plaintiff's standard banking terms and conditions.
3. Costs.
