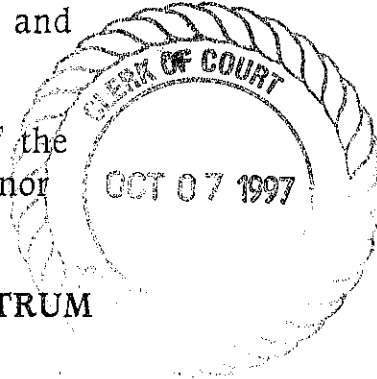

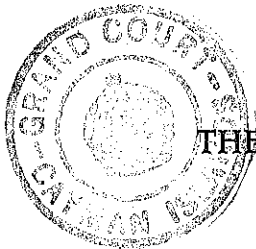

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons, counting the day of service, return the accompanying acknowledgement of service to the Courts Office, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons which is issued on the application of the Applicant, Johnny Buttrum, of Grand Cayman, the Applicant claims the following relief, namely, an Order:

1. That the I be appointed guardian, with custody care and control, of Danielle Laurice Lalgie - a minor;
2. That the child reside with me and my wife in Windsor Park, George Town, Grand Cayman;
3. That the child be permitted to go to school in Grand Cayman in the private rather than the public sector.

The said Minor, Danielle Laurice Lalgie, was born on February 9th, 1997.

The present whereabouts of the Minor is that she is with her stepfather (the Applicant in the said matter) and her biological mother, Winsome Elizabeth Buttrum, at their home in Windsor Park, George Town, Grand Cayman.

The interest in or relationship to the Minor of the Applicant is that of stepfather.

The child's biological father of the child is from Grenada and he has not contact with the child and does nothing to support her.

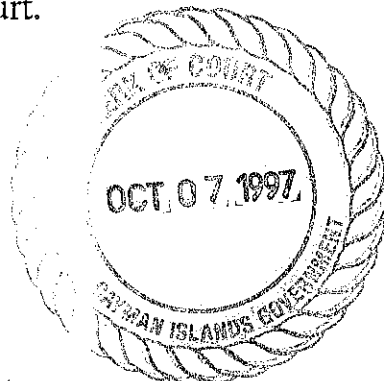
