UPON HEARING Counsel for the Applicant, Mr Philip Boni, there being no appearance for
the Registrar of Companies;

AND UPON reading the Originating Summons and the Affidavit of **Lennox Arthur Persad**
sworn on the 15th day of September, 1997 and filed on the 25th day of September, 1997 and
INTERNATIONAL OILFIELD EQUIPMENT LIMITED by its Counsel undertaking to file with
the Registrar of Companies all necessary returns under the Companies Law and to pay
within seven days of the date hereof all fees, penalties and other monies due to the
Registrar of Companies which total CI\$4,297.00;

IT IS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the said **INTERNATIONAL MUD SERVICES LIMITED** be restored to the Register of Companies and be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck from the Register of Companies upon payment of the sum of CI\$4,297.00 and all other monies payable to the Registrar of Companies within seven days of the date hereof.
2. That a duly sealed copy of this Order be served upon the Registrar of Companies who shall thereupon advertise this Order once in the Cayman Islands Gazette.

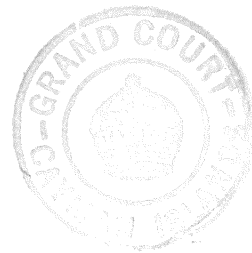
