

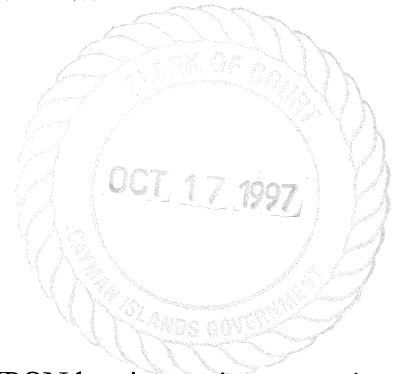

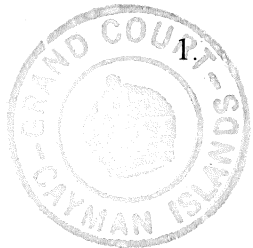

ORDER

UPON THIS MATTER coming on for hearing this day AND UPON hearing senior counsel for the Petitioner and counsel for the Respondent AND UPON reading the affidavits filed by the Petitioner and the Respondent, **It is hereby ordered** as follows:-




1. That the Petitioner and the Respondent shall have joint custody of the two children of the marriage, namely, TIMOTHY ROBINSON HAWKES, born on the 21st February, 1987, and, HANNAH FRANCIS HAWKES, born on the 19th May, 1992, with the Petitioner having the day to day care and control of the children.
2. That the mediation agreement made between the Petitioner and the Respondent dated the 10th September, 1997 and attached as Schedule One to this Order, shall form part of the order of this Court.
3. That the Respondent shall pay the Petitioner the sum of CI\$8,000.00 towards the cost of relocation of the Petitioner and the children of the marriage to New South Wales, Australia.

4. That the Respondent shall pay the sum of US\$3,000.00 per month to the Petitioner as maintenance for the Petitioner and the children of the marriage for the first six months after arrival in New South Wales, Australia, in advance, on or before the first day of each month.
5. At the end of the aforesaid six months, the Respondent shall pay the sum of US\$2,000.00 to the Petitioner in advance on or before the first day of each month as maintenance for the two children of the marriage.
6. That the Petitioner and the Respondent have agreed, among themselves, to divide the remaining personal matrimonial property.
7. That there be liberty to apply generally.
8. That there be no order as to costs.
