Within 14 days after service of this Complaint on you, counting the day of service you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court office, PO Box 495GT, George Town Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service form stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out **full particulars of your defence** in the space provided in the Acknowledgement of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or fail to return the Acknowledgement of Service form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiff may apply for a **default judgment** without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Defendant is and was at all material times resident and domiciled in the Cayman Islands.
2. In June 2017, the Defendant issued a cheque to the Cayman Islands Government for the payment of services which, was dishonoured by the bank and returned to the Government due to insufficient funds. The details of the dishonoured cheque are:

3. The total sum owed to the Cayman Islands Government is CI\$2,440.00, inclusive of administration fees.
4. A posted demand for payment was returned by the postal service noting "box close" and attempts to contact the Defendant by phone have been unsuccessful.
5. To date the Defendant has failed or neglected to make full payment on this amount to the Plaintiff.
6. As a result of the above, the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief claimed in this proceeding.
7. The Defendant should also pay interest at the prescribed rate on the debt as at the date of this Plaint as well as at the per diem rate until the debt has been paid in full.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

- a. CI\$2,440.00 being the total sum due to the Plaintiff.
- b. Interest on the principal sum of CI\$2,400.00 in the amount of CI\$57.00 calculated at the prescribed rate from 31 July, 2017 to date.
- c. Interest to continue at the per diem rate of CI\$0.18 until the matter is settled.

d. Fixed costs at CI\$150.00 or as to be assessed.
