

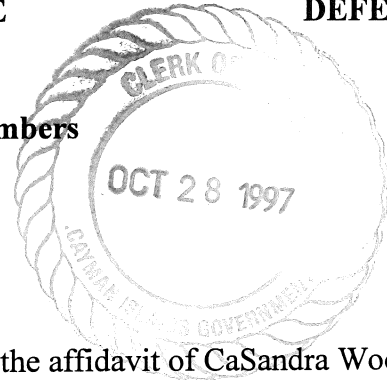

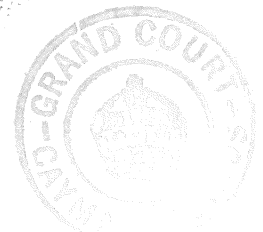
**UPON HEARING** Counsel for the Plaintiff and upon reading the affidavit of CaSandra Wood sworn on 30 July 1997
