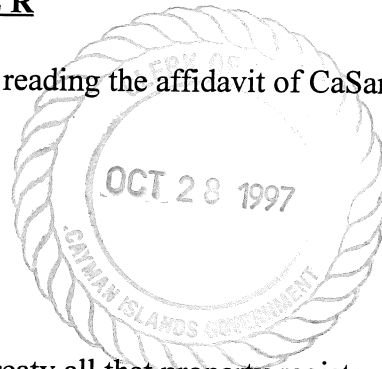

UPON HEARING Counsel for the Plaintiff and upon reading the affidavit of CaSandra Wood sworn on 30th July 1997

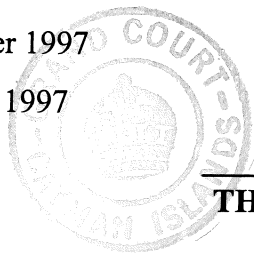


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:
