
STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff at all material times was selling furniture and residing at 67 Oak Mill Street, George Town, Grand Cayman.
2. The Defendant at all material times was and is employed at Fairbanks Woman Prison, George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. From on or about October 2012 the Defendant became a customer of the Plaintiff purchasing furniture from him from time to time. Since that time the Plaintiff has supplied various pieces on account.
4. The many pieces of furniture supplied to the Defendant included:
 - Living Room set
 - Bed Room set
 - Dressers
 - Dining Room setThe total price for all the furniture supplied to the Defendant is the sum of CI\$ 9,150:00. On or about November 2016 the Defendant made a payment on her account in the sum of CI\$ 1,300:00.
5. The Defendant has a balance of payment on her account with the Plaintiff in the sum of CI\$ 7,850:00. Despite numerous requests from the Plaintiff to collect the sum of CI\$ 7,850:00 owed to him by the Defendant, the Defendant refused and continues to refuse to pay him.

And The Defendant Claims:-

1. The Sum of CI\$ 7,850:00;
2. Interest at the rate of 8 3/8% from the date of November 2016 to the date of Judgment;
3. Costs
4. Court Cost of CI\$ 25:00;
5. Such Further or other relief as the Court deem fit.
