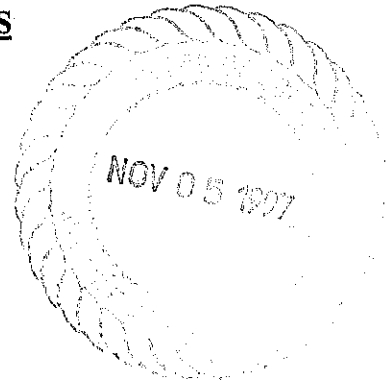
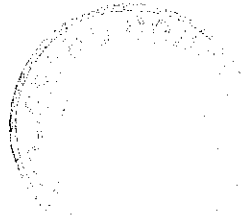

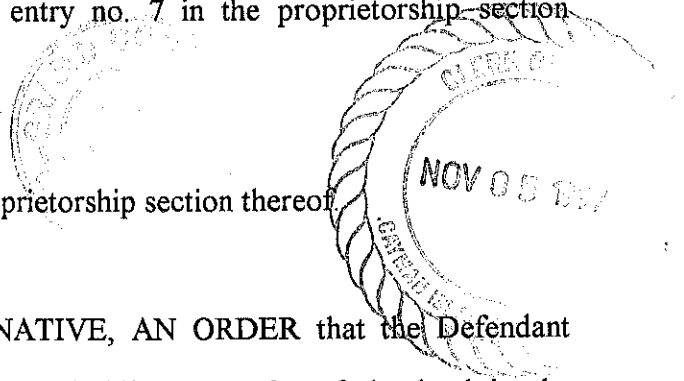

LET THE DEFENDANT, within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons on her, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office, P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, B.W.I.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Joyce Robinson, of PO Box 1117, Alamo Drive, Crewe Road, George Town, Grand Cayman and of Kenneth Nembhard, of 6508 Merriewood Drive, Orlando, state of Florida 32818, one of the United States of America, in their capacity as guardians of, and receivers for, Selvin Nembhard, the Plaintiffs claim against the Defendant:


1. A DECLARATION that the transfer of the land described as Registration Section George Town Central, Block 14CF, Parcel 17 ("the land") by Selvin Nembhard as sole proprietor thereof to himself and the Defendant jointly of 24th September, 1996, which was registered on 19th November, 1996, is void and of no effect.
2. AN ORDER that the register of the land be rectified by:
 - (a) directing the cancellation of entry no. 7 in the proprietorship section thereof and
 - (b) restoring entry no. 6 in the proprietorship section thereof
3. FURTHER AND IN THE ALTERNATIVE, AN ORDER that the Defendant execute and deliver, jointly with the Plaintiffs, a transfer of the land in the prescribed form from herself and the said Selvin Nembhard as joint proprietors thereof to the Plaintiffs as guardians of, and receivers for, Selvin Nembhard within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the judgment sought herein.



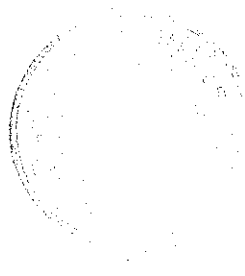
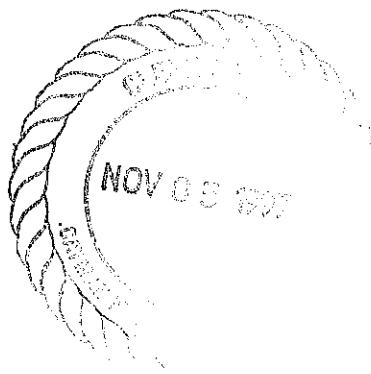
4. AN ACCOUNT of all sums received by the Defendant as rental income with respect to the land.
5. ALL FUTHER proper accounts, enquiries and directions.
6. PAYMENT to the Plaintiffs of all sums found to be due by the Defendant as a result of the accounting referred to in paragraphs 4 and 5 hereof.
7. FURTHER and/or other relief.
8. AN ORDER that the Defendant pay the Plaintiffs' costs of this action.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to her as the Court may think just and expedient.

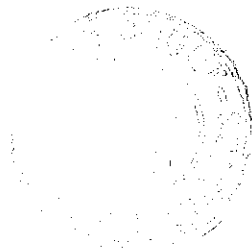

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE OF ORIGINATING
SUMMONS

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. The Defendant is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Court's Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner), you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, an originating summons served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY, the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Court's Office.

Notes on address for service


Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
