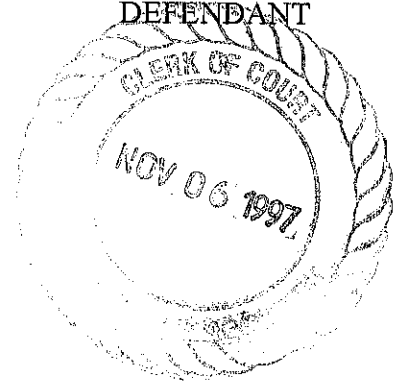

WRIT OF SUMMONS



THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

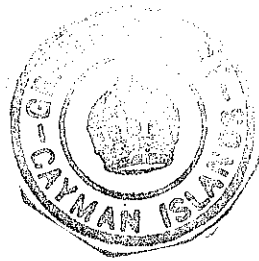

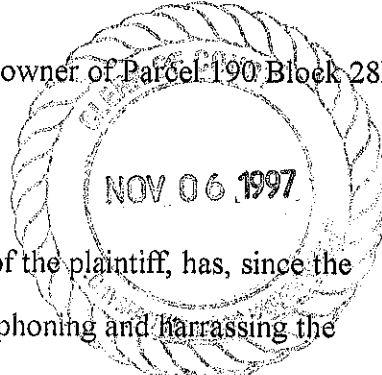

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a police officer and the registered owner of Parcel 190 Block 28D in Savannah Acres where the plaintiff lives
2. The defendant who is the former intimate friend of the plaintiff, has, since the break up of the relationship, been constantly telephoning and harrassing the plaintiff at his work and at his home; following him wherever he goes and has on several occasions entered his home, damage his plants and/or molest him and/or his guests.
3. Despite a letter, dated the 17th day of July, 1997 from the plaintiff's Attorneys, to the defendant warning her to desist her harrassment of the plaintiff, the defendant, on the 20th October, 1997, in her car, followed the plaintiff around, in his truck, from about 7:30 p.m. until about 10:30 p.m. when she drove her car into the back of the plaintiff's truck, damaging her car's radiator.
4. The plaintiff, upon the request of the defendant, permitted the defendant to enter his house to make a telephone call to her house for help but the defendant, after making the call, refused the plaintiff's request to leave his house. Instead, the defendant got into a rage, accused the plaintiff of wanting to get the opportunity to have sexual intercourse with a female guest in his house and attacked the plaintiff with two knives, one in each hand.



5. In his attempt to defend himself by wrestling the knife from the defendant, the defendant bite the plaintiff on his arm by reason of which the plaintiff has suffered pain and injury, loss and damage.

PARTICULARS OF INJURY

1. Bruise to the medial aspect of the left arm.

PARTICULARS OF SPECIAL DAMAGE

1. Medical bill \$35.00

AND the plaintiff's claim is for:-

1. Damages.
2. An order that the defendant be restrained and an injunction be granted restraining her either by herself or by her agents or servants or otherwise howsoever from entering upon the plaintiff's property; making threats towards the plaintiff, telephoning the plaintiff, either at his home or at his work place or molesting, assaulting or otherwise interfering with the plaintiff.
3. Costs to be taxed or agreed.
