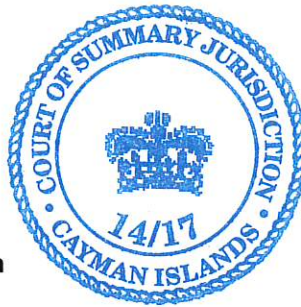


PLAINT

On or about March 19th 2018, 2nd Defendant Patrick N. Watler was driving vehicle Nissan Pathfinder registration #182116 in the vicinity of Comfort Suites West Bay Road when he collided into the rear of the Plaintiff's vehicle VW Beetle registration #Q4556 whilst she had stopped at a pedestrian crossing to allow a female to cross, causing major damage to the vehicle totaling CI\$3,002.00.

The 1st Defendant was the owner of the vehicle when the 2nd Defendant collided into the rear of the Plaintiff's vehicle.

On the day of the accident, 2nd Defendant provided a statement under caution at the George Town Police Station accepting full responsibility for the damages to the vehicle.

The Plaintiff has tried on several occasions to obtain the cost for the damage to the vehicle from the Defendants but to no avail.
