
BY THIS ORIGINATING SUMMONS, which is issued on the application of the Applicant, Leonard
Hecht of 729 7th Avenue, 14 Floor, New York, New York 10019, United States of America, in his

capacity as the co-executor named in the Will of the late Norma Phyllis Bruhl who died on 10 July 2016, the Applicant seeks the following relief pursuant to GCR Order 85, rule 2(2)(a) or the inherent jurisdiction of the Court:

1. An order that the hearing of this Originating Summons be heard in private;
2. An order that the Applicant be at liberty to participate in proceedings commenced by Peter A. Broadhurst in his capacity as Executor of the Estate of John Lothar Bruhl (deceased) in Grand Court FSD Cause No. 168 of 2018 (the **Action**) against the respondents and for the directions described more fully in the Affidavit of Leonard Hecht filed herein;
3. An order that the Applicant be indemnified against any and all costs and expenses arising out of, and incidental to, the Action out of the assets of the Estate of the said Norma Phyllis Bruhl (deceased);
4. An order that provision be made for the costs of this application; and
5. There be such further or alternative relief granted as the Court shall think fit.

AND LET THE RESPONDENTS, within 14 days after service of this Originating Summons, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Court Office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, KY1-1106.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
