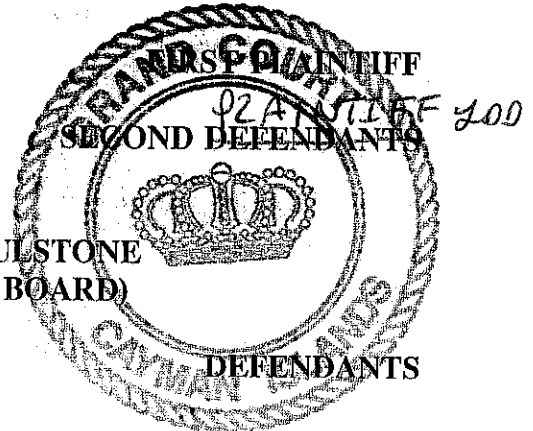




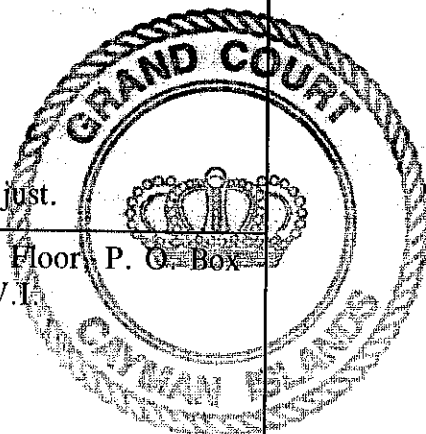
APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO APPLY FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW

Judgment, order, decision or other proceeding in respect of which relief is sought	Letter dated the 7th day of March 1997 advising of the decision of the Liquor Licensing Board ("the Board") to revoke the Liquor License pursuant to section 5(1) of the Liquor Licensing Law 1996 Revision ("the Law") to take effect on being communicated to applicant officially.

Relief Sought

1. An order for certiorari quashing the decision made by the Defendant on the 7th March 1997 whereby the Board purportedly revoked the license granted by it to the applicant on the 11th October 1996.
2. A declaration that the license granted should stand and that the decision to revoke the license is void and/or unlawful and/or a nullity.
3. By way of interim relief: (i) a stay of proceedings under Ord. 53, r. 3 so as to suspend the operation of the decision of the Board made on the 7th March 1997 until the determination of the application for judicial review herein or until the court otherwise orders, and/or (ii) to restrain the Board through its servants, agents or otherwise from taking any steps to enforce compliance with the said decision of the Board until the application for judicial review herein or until further order.
4. The applicant seeks an oral hearing of the application for leave. MAR. 12, 1997
5. Damages.
6. Costs.
7. Such further and/or other relief as this Honourable Court deems just.

GROUND ON WHICH RELIEF IS SOUGHT

1. The facts upon which this application for leave to apply by way of judicial review for an order of certiorari to quash the decision of the Board purportedly made on the 7th March 1997 is based are fully set out in the affidavits of Mr. Ernest Bodden and Mr. Harry Lalli sworn and filed herein to which the applicants crave leave to refer.
2. Having regard to the facts set out in paragraphs 2-19 of Mr. Ernest Bodden's affidavit the legal basis and grounds upon which the order is sought and the relief claimed in the

application form filed herein is that the decision purportedly made on the 7th March 1997 by the Board is void and of no legal effect because it is tainted by illegality, irrationality and procedural impropriety and is unfair.

3. Accordingly the Applicants respectfully request a hearing in Chambers of this application pursuant to Ord. 53, r. 3(3) of the Grand Court Rules, 1995.
