AND UPON reading the Fifth Affidavit of Jeffrey Stower sworn on 12 December 2018 and Exhibit JS-11 thereto, and the Second Affidavit of Rachel Catherine Baxendale sworn on 11 January 2019 and Exhibit RCB-2 thereto

AND UPON reading the Skeleton Argument on behalf of Mr Beighton and Mr Stower dated 16 January 2019
