

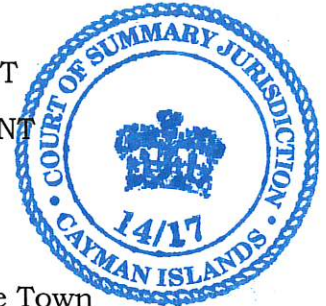

THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiffs in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

WITHIN 14 DAYS AFTER SERVICE OF THIS PLAINT on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court's Office, P.O.Box 495, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service form stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to contest the action whole or in part, you must set out full particulars of your defence in the space provided in the Acknowledgment of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or fail to return the Acknowledgment of Service form containing full particulars of your defence, the Plaintiffs may apply for a Default judgment without further notice to you.


10. The plaintiffs and their attorneys have made demands of the defendants for payment of the said sums but these demands proved unsuccessful.
11. Accordingly, the plaintiffs claim from the defendants arrears of rent and light bill, late payment penalty, daily penalty and repair costs for breach of the Lease in the sum of CI\$7,860.50.
12. In addition to the principal sum of CI\$7,860.50 due, the plaintiffs are entitled to Pre- and Post Judgment interest on the said sums at the statutory rate of 2 3/8 % per annum pursuant to the Judicature Law (2013 Revision) and the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest Rules as prescribed from time to time. Particulars of interest are set out in the schedule attached hereto.
13. Pre-Judgment interest from October 1, 2017 to January 29, 2019 is calculated at CI\$232.20.

WHEREFORE THE PLAINTIFFS CLAIM FROM THE DEFENDANTS:-

1. Payment of the principal sum of CI\$7,860.50
2. Pre-Judgment Interest on the said sum of CI\$232,20
3. Further interest pursuant to the Judicature Law and Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest Rules)
4. Costs to be taxed if not agreed
