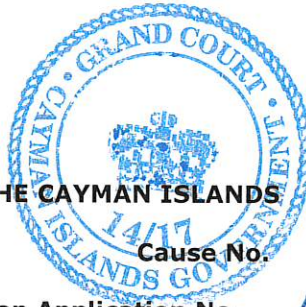

**APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL

We, **KAREN A. HUNTER** of 74 Coralstone Way, Savannah, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, **DESIREE A. BRODHURST** of 2040 Springfield Avenue, Kelowna, British Columbia, V1Y 9N7, Canada, and **BRYAN A. HUNTER** of 367 Jennifer Drive, West Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands KY1-1203, being the joint executrices and executor named in the last Will of the late Arthur Berkley Hunter, formerly of 74 Coralstone Way, Savannah, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, surviving the deceased, being over the age of eighteen years and not having renounced probate, which said Will was made in Grand Cayman on the 31st day of October 2018, and the said Will, at the time of death of the deceased, having been found in his files at his residence of 74 Coralstone Way, Savannah, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, which said Will, together with the certificate of death, is annexed hereto, hereby apply for a grant of probate of the said Will to us and we enclose herewith our Affidavit in that behalf and we undertake that in the event of such grant being made to us, we will:

- (a) within six (6) months of the grant of probate to us of the said Will prepare a true inventory of the said estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one (1) year of such grant to us administer the said estate according to the tenor of the Will and the directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.



I, ARTHUR BERKLEY HUNTER of "Bats Cave" 74 Coralstone Way, Savannah in the Island of Grand Cayman HEREBY REVOKE all Wills, Codicils and Testamentary Dispositions heretofore made by me and DECLARE this to be my Last Will and Testament.

1. I HEREBY appoint my wife Karen A. Hunter of "Bats Cave" aforesaid, my daughter, Desiree Ann Brodhurst of Kelowna, B.C., Canada and my son, Bryan Arthur Hunter of Snug Harbour, Grand Cayman (hereinafter called my "Executors") to be the Executrices and Executor of this my Will. The said Bryan Arthur Hunter being an Attorney-at-Law shall be entitled to charge, retain and be paid all usual professional or other charges for business done by him or his firm in relation to the administrator of my Estate or the execution of any Trusts created by this my Will including acts which an Executor or Trustee could do personally.
2. I GIVE AND BEQUEATH
 - a) To my son, Bryan Arthur all of my personal effects including but not limited to my jewellery and paperweights. It is my wish that Bryan will, in his discretion, share my jewellery and paperweights with my three grandsons.
 - b) To my grandson Rory Brodhurst my 1989 Model Mercedes Benz 560 sports car.
 - c) To my wife, Karen Ann absolutely all other articles and effects of household or domestic use, ornament or consumption belonging to me.
3. I GIVE AND BEQUEATH unto my Executors upon Trust for sale my shares in Huntlaw Ltd. a Cayman Islands Company as well as all cash in hand and in Bank for the account of the said Company and all cash in Bank which may be owned by me personally or held for my own account to be held by them and the proceeds thereof applied and/or distributed in the following manner:
 - (a) Firstly in payment of all my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses.
 - (b) Secondly to pay the sum of Ten Thousand Cayman Islands Dollars to my trusted helper Rudolph Black
 - (c) Thirdly to pay to my brother George the sum of One Hundred Thousand Cayman Islands Dollars.
4. Subject to the payments mentioned in Clause 3 above and to the terms of clause 5 hereof, I direct my Executors to pay the remaining cash funds and all proceeds derived from the Trust for sale of the shares in Huntlaw Ltd. to my wife, Karen Ann absolutely. In the event that my said wife shall pre-decease me then all of the said remaining cash funds and all proceeds derived from the said Trust for Sale shall be paid to my daughter, Desiree and my son, Bryan in equal shares.
5. Having agreed to sell all of my shares in Cayman National Corporation Limited, I direct my Executors to disburse the proceeds derived therefrom in the following manner:

(a) The sum of One Million United States Dollars to each of my two children viz: Desiree and Bryan provided, however, that should said amounts be paid to them during my lifetime this bequest shall lapse and be of no effect.

(b) The sum of One Hundred Thousand United States Dollars to each of my four grandchildren.

© The income from the remainder of the said proceeds or any investments made therefrom shall be paid to or applied for the benefit of my wife, Karen during her lifetime and upon her death shall be paid to my two children, Desiree and Bryan in equal shares.

6. I GIVE AND BEQUEATH unto my Executors all of my shares in Jacques Scott Group Ltd., to be held by them upon the following trusts:


(a) Upon Trust to pay to my wife Karen A. during her lifetime all dividends and/or income derived from said shares.

(b) Upon the death of my said wife to transfer the ownership of said shares into the names of my two children, Bryan Arthur Hunter and Desiree Ann Brodhurst in equal portions.



MY EXECUTORS are hereby authorised in the discharge of their duties to employ Counsel, Attorneys-at-Law, Accountants and Agents and to determine the amount of their reasonable compensation and to pay the same and to reimburse themselves from and out of my estate as they in their discretion consider proper and to further reimburse themselves from and out of the said estate for all other necessary incurred expenses in the administration of my estate and of the trusts hereby created.

We make this Affidavit in support of our application in the premises.






