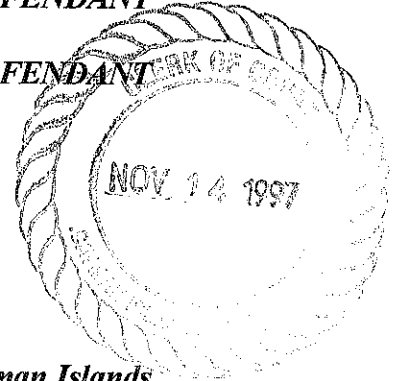

***If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.***

The Plaintiff brings this action under and by virtue of the Crown Proceedings Law and claims against the Defendant to recover damages for on or about the 17<sup>th</sup> day of November 1994 the First Named Defendant negligently drove Jeep Wrangler motor vehicle licensed number 40 089, the property of the Second Named Defendant, along the Savannah Main Road in the vicinity of the Tall Tree Store, Grand Cayman, thereby causing the same to collide with Chevrolet Chevy Van (Ambulance) licensed number 18 788, the property of the Cayman Islands Government, being driven in the opposite direction along the said road, and as a consequence of which the said Cayman Islands Government has sustained loss and damage.
