## PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

2. I made three deposits totalling CI\$1,800.00 to Ms. Mary Lou Dixon.
3. The vehicle was not working at the time, I had to purchase several parts in an attempt to get it fixed until I became frustrated. I had to return the vehicle to Ms. Mary Lou Dixon.
4. Ms. Mary Lou Dixon promised to return my deposit of CI\$1,800.00 to me but after several weeks there was no refund forthcoming, she kept saying "I soon get to you!"
5. Last December, 2018 I went to her and she said that the vehicle I was not working, however, she has been seen in East End several times driving the vehicle, and at the Bodden Town Gas Station in the said vehicle
6. To date Ms. Mary-Lou has not provided a refund to me in any amount whatsoever, as promised.

- 1 The sum of CI\$1,800.00
- 2 Fixed costs of \$150.00 + \$25.00 filing fee alternatively costs to be assessed.
