

BY THIS SUMMONS, which is issued on the application of **CHRISTINE EBANKS**, of 105 Velma Banks Drive, West Bay, Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff claims against the Defendant a Declaration that the Defendants are contractually bound to transfer to her property being Registration Section West Bay North West Block 4B Parcel 537 pursuant to an agreement for the same to be sold to her entered into by the Plaintiff and Ella Mae Bothwell, acting as agent for the first and second named Defendants in the sum of CI\$45,000.00 and seeks an Order that the Defendants do transfer the said property to her on the payment of CI\$4,425.00.

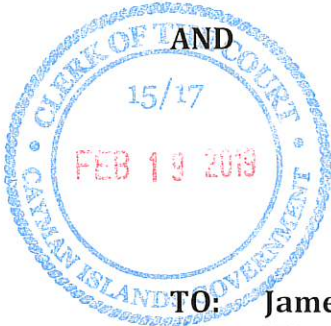
IF THE DEFENDANTS do not acknowledge service, such Judgment may be given or an order made against or in relation to them as the Court may think just and expedient.

IMPORTANT

Directions for Acknowledgment of Service are given with the accompanying form.

This Originating Summons was issued by Murray & Westerborg, Attorneys-at-Law, for and on behalf of the Plaintiff whose address for service is that of her said Attorneys-at-Law, The Second Floor (Southwest Wing) Cayman Shipping Centre Building, 10 Shipping Lane, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a Plaintiff served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Plaintiff)".
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an Attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

Notes on address for service

Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered or principal office.
