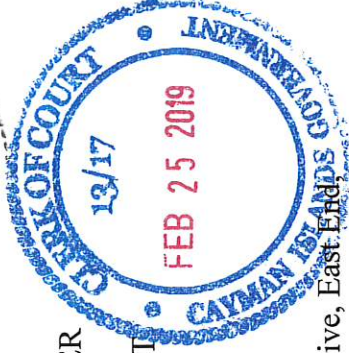

PETITION FOR THE DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

The Humble Petition of Joel Dwight Bodden of 553 John McLean Drive, East End, Grand Cayman for the Dissolution of Marriage shows:

1. That on the 17th day of December, 2011 at Edmonton, Alberta, Canada the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the said marriage, the status of the parties was as follows:-

Joel Dwight Bodden- Single
 Jessica Ann Jurgens - Single

2. That following the celebration of the said marriage the parties lived and cohabited in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada , then in Newlands, Grand Cayman and finally in East End, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. That this Honourable Court has jurisdiction in the above cause by reason of the fact that the Petitioner and the Respondent are Caymanian who have lived in the Cayman Islands all their lives.
4. That there have been no proceeding in or outside the Cayman Islands with respect to the marriage. There were Summary Court proceeding with respect to, inter alia, the maintenance of the child which was finally determined at CI\$320.00 per month in SMA 3 of 2013.
5. That there are no arrangements between the parties for the consideration of this Honourable Court.
6. That there is no impediment to this Court granting a decree of dissolution of marriage to the knowledge of the Petitioner and there is no prospect whatsoever of a reconciliation between the parties.

7. That there is one child of the family, namely, Annalayah Jasmine Bodden born on the 24th January, 2012.

8. The Petitioner proposes the following arrangements for the custody, care and control, access, maintenance and education of the child of the marriage:-
- a) That the Respondent be granted a residence order with liberal contact to the Petitioner to be agreed or defined by the Court in the absence of agreement.
 - b) That the petitioner will continue to pay maintenance for the child to the tune of CI\$320.00 per month until she reaches 18 years of age or complete her first university degree(up to age 21years) whichever is later.
 - c) That the petitioner will pay one half of the medical, dental and optical expenses incurred by the child over and above those covered by the Respondent's health insurance plan until she reaches the age of 18 years or complete her first university degree(up to age 21years), whichever is later.
 - d) That the parties will share equally the child's educational expenses until she reaches the age of 18 years or complete her first university degree up to age 21years) , whichever is later.
8. That there is no matrimonial property or assets owned by the parties.
9. That the marriage has irretrievably broken down by reason of the fact that since the celebration of the marriage, the respondent and the petitioner have lived separate and apart for more than five years, ie since 2012.

PARTICULARS

The Respondent vacated the matrimonial home in September 2012 and never returned.

The parties have not attempted to reconcile since that time.

The Petitioner therefore prays:-

- (i) That the Court grants a decree of dissolution of marriage.
- (ii) That ancillary matters be adjourned to chambers
- (iii) That there be such further and/or other relief as the Honourable Court deems appropriate.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE OF DIVORCE PETITION

IF YOU INTEND TO INSTRUCT AN ATTORNEY TO ACT FOR YOU GIVE HIM THIS FORM IMMEDIATELY.

1. The accompanying form of Acknowledgement for Service should be completed by an attorney acting on behalf of the Respondent or by Respondent acting in person.
2. After completion it must be signed by the Respondent and his attorney (if any) and must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O.Box 495 GT, and Grand Cayman.
3. The Acknowledgement of Service must be filed at court and served on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after the service of the Petition.
4. A Respondent who states in his Acknowledgement of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an "undefended petition" in respect of which a decree of divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open court unless an acknowledgement of service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the Court office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
- 6.) In case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgement of Service an any Answer are extended by fourteen days.
