PETITION FOR THE DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THE PETITION OF **TYRONE O'DWAIN DUNN** WHOSE ADDRESS FOR SERVICE IS P.O BOX 11460 APO, 79 RYAN ROAD, GEORGE TOWN, GRAND CAYMAN KY1-1009, CAYMAN ISLANDS SHOWS:

- (1) That on the 28th of September 2007 at 11 Boltins Avenue, West Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands the above Petitioner was lawfully married to the above Respondent and at the time of the said marriage, the marital status of the parties was as follows: -
 - (a) The Petitioner was Bachelor

And

 - (b) The Respondent was Spinster
- (2) That following the celebration of the said marriage the parties lived and cohabited in the Cayman Islands at Apt#79, Owen Roberts Drive, George Town, Grand Cayman.
- (3) That this Court has Jurisdiction in this case by reason of the fact that the Petitioner has been ordinarily domiciled in the Cayman Islands since the date of marriage and continues to be domiciled in the Cayman Islands.
- (4) That there are no previous proceedings brought by the parties hereto in court with respect of the said marriage.

- (5) That there is no impediment to this Honorable Court granting a decree of dissolution to the said marriage to the knowledge of the Petitioner.
- (6) That there is one biological child born in wedlock. The Petitioner is the biological father of Nathanel O'Dwain Demetrius Dunn born 15th of November 2007, namely "the Child of the Marriage". The Respondent gave birth to three other children outside the marriage.
- (7) That there are no matrimonial assets held for consideration of the court.
- (8) That there are no arrangements between the parties for the consideration of this Court in these proceedings, except it is agreed that the Petitioner will continue to have a residence order in respect to his biological Child of the Marriage.
- (9) That the marriage between the parties has broken down irretrievable and there is no prospect whatsoever of a reconciliation.

PARTICULARS OF SEPARATION

- (a) The Respondent and Petitioner were in a relationship for over two years, prior to becoming married on 28th September 2007. The Petitioner fathered one child in wedlock. The Petitioner has taken full responsibility for this child. That the Petitioner and Respondent were well acquainted prior to being married on 28th of September 2007 and the marriage was relatively happy for the first four years of marriage.
- (b) That the marriage between the above-named parties has severely broken down without any possibility of reconciliation since the Petitioner and the Respondent's relationship has deteriorated significantly over the years, to the point that they are unable to co-exist in the same household. The Petitioner and Respondent has lived apart for a continuous period of over eight years.
- (c) That there is a lack of trust in the marriage and it has been this way for several years whereby the either party does not trust each other resulting in frequent arguments. The Petitioner and the Respondent acknowledge that the marriage has failed and do not desire reconciliation.
- (d) That the Petitioner and the Respondent have consistently shown that they are unable to co-exist in an intimate relationship. All attempts at reconciliation have failed and the marriage is irreparable.

- (e) That the Petitioner and the Respondent agreed to pursue a divorce since the Respondent has started a new family and wishes to remarry. It is agreed by both parties to dissolve the marriage as there is no prospect for reconciliation.

THE PETITIONER THEREFORE PRAYS:

1. That the said marriage be dissolved.
2. That this Honorable Court do continue to allow the Petitioner to have a residence order in relation to the paternal Child of the Marriage, namely Nathanel O'Dwain Demetrius Dunn, with the Respondent having liberal contact to the Child.
3. That this Honorable Court does make any order that it may deem just.
4. Such further and other order as this Court deems just and equitable.
